Old News Report

Treasurer – Balance as of 9/5/2023 \$4737.55

President- last purchase for girls practice/game speaker went out was asked by coach Griffin and approved and 2nd

New News Report

By laws Article VI line to be totally removed to allow old/existing officers and new prospective offers to be re-elected. A motion was called and 2nd to approve to remove Article VI “All officers are eligible for re-election...”

Concessions -President proposed to purchase a new popcorn machine to keep up with the demand from the consumers. The total investment costs is \$350.00. In addition to having the popcorn machine for girls basketball team home games when not in use the machine can also be rented for \$50.00 to other organizations. Motion called and 2nd to approve the purchase of the popcorn machine was approved.

Concessions-President and Coach Griffin proposed to hire a “home day concession stand worker”. This worker shall work all home games JV and Varsity only at a rate of \$20.00 per game total of \$40 per game. A motion was called and 2nd to approve to hire a concession stand worker was approved for home games at a rate of \$40 per home game.

Concessions-Coach Griffin encouraged parents on the call to volunteer concessions so there would be no need to hire a concession stand worker.

Flock Party- will be held during homecoming for freshman in the back of the school. Coach Griffin proposed an approval of \$300.00 for a fundraiser prize that will drive students to participate in a shoot

off during the flock party. The prize is unknown at this time. The amount of \$300.00 was approved for the fundraiser prize. (Samantha said she would attempt to reach out to Brian with Chic Fil A for sponsorship for the grand prize instead of using the approved \$300.00 to purchase the prize. This is not confirmed yet)

Sponsorship- Coach Griffin and President Ken encouraged parents on the call to begin looking for sponsorship for the team. Explained that the sponsors would receive name recognition during the games and visible advertisements by pamphlets or ads in the gym depending on the amount spent.

*Meet The Teacher/Fall Ball -*Meet the Teacher will be the same day as the game vs Pearland. Coach Griffin encouraged parents to attend meet the teacher and try to also support the game if possible.

Sports You- Coach Griffin inquired if parents like the new app "Sports You". An app used to communicate to the team and parents on current events, games, practices etc. Parents all agreed they preferred Sports You vs the emails. Coach intends to continue to communicate using the app.
